b. Exhibits to be delivered to the Pavilion by 9.00 am Friday, completed.

c. Exhibitors must bring exhibits in suitable containers, with adequate water.

d. Number and Section must be marked on each container.

e. Stewards will assist everyone as much as possible, but exhibitors must be responsible for attaching their entry tickets to their own exhibits, to avoid mistakes.

f. No leaf shine or wax permitted on entries in the Potted Plant Section.

g. Definitions: (The Royal Horticultural Soc. of NSW Standard Reference Book)

Distinct: The term "Distinct" means different.

N.N.D.: Not necessarily distinct means an exhibit need not necessarily consist of different varieties.

A.O.V.: Any other variety.

h. Exhibitors must have entries checked by stewards for correctness.
