All entries must be the work of the exhibitor.
All produce and fleece entries must be grown/produced by the exhibitor.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

- a. Pavilion judging will be done on Friday, 6th March 2026 unless otherwise specified.
- b. Art and Photography entries must be delivered to the Show Office or Art Chief Steward no later than 5pm on the day all entries close – Wednesday, 4th March, 2026 at 5 pm.
- c. All other exhibits must be at the pavilion by 9.00 am Friday. Exhibitors may deliver entries to Show Office before Show day.
- d. Judging will commence at 9.30 am unless otherwise specified.
- e. Pavilion will open for public viewing at 8.00 am Saturday.
- f. Pavilion will close to the public at 4.00 pm on Saturday.
- g. Exhibits may be collected from the pavilion after 4.30 pm Saturday.
- h. In Junior Sections, proof of age is to be provided if requested.
- i. Junior and school classes are free to enter in all sections. If a junior exhibitor wishes to enter an open class, entry will be as advertised for that section.
- j. Judges will not divide prizes. They will not award prizes if exhibits possess insufficient merit. Judges' decisions are final.
- k. If less than three entries in a class, a second prize may not be awarded.
- l. When entering exhibits Name of the Class, not the exhibit, must be written on the entry form.
- m. Where possible equal placings in judging is to be discouraged as it affects the overall outcome for the most successful exhibitor, e.g. 2 firsts = 6 points which has to be halved - 3 points, whereas a 1st and a 2nd = 5 points for the same exhibitor.
- n. An unadvertised Prize may be given in lieu of prizemoney, at the discretion of the section Chief Steward.
